Participants will have some afternoons and one full day off to explore the city and enjoy the local culture and community. The cost to be a part of this great opportunity is only \$50 (due at the time application is submitted). If not selected for the trip, money will be refunded. A minimum 2.25 GPA is required to apply, and you may not be on probation for academic or disciplinary reasons. You must currently be enrolled in classes at CF, and planning to be enrolled in Spring 2018.
